### **Minutes**

**Ordeal-** Went Great! 111 People attended, 23 new candidates inducted, 9 transitioned to Brotherhood, and 6 were bestowed the Vigil Honor.

#### **LLD – Amanda**

We are preparing for the LLD in December. Nobody had any suggestions on classes that we need to offer. A survey will be given at the next LEC.

#### **University of Scouting – Amanda**

Dean of Service – Josh Williams – responsible for recruiting Arrowmen to fill the service positions and OA operations at U of S

Classes - It was suggested to offer a general OA class which would include an introduction to the OA and explanations of what opportunities are available Beyond the Ordeal. Tommy volunteered to teach this class. It was also suggested to offer a Brotherhood preparation class for Arrowmen only. Jacob Wirz and Chris Torok volunteered to teach the Brotherhood prep class. The U of S committee will meet and discuss whether or not to offer this class, as youth need an all-day program. It may need to be incorporated into YLT.

Concessions – will be sold by the OA and it will be advertised in the registration packet.

OA Store - we will add the store this year and it will also be advertised.

Engraver – a volunteer is needed to be responsible for it at U of S and at all events. A nametag preorder form will be included in the registration packet. Tommy will work on the updating the order form. Metal nametags need to be ordered.

OA Service Corps – will be available to help participants. This will be announced at the Opening of U of S and it will also be noted in the registration packets. The patches need to have the correct spelling this year, Corps not Core. Amanda will talk with Natalie about the patches.

**Training** – It was suggested to offer a Brotherhood prep class at the Ordeals, possibly after lunch, proceeding the Brotherhood study time.

**Cub N'Partners** – The last week-end is tomorrow. We still need a few more volunteers to work in the kitchen. Bill Lupia, Bill Seymour, Lori Moore, and Jacob Wirz are helping at the last week-end.

**Endurance Ride** – November 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>. We need volunteers to work in the kitchen. Nobody is

available that week-end. Adrian can help on Saturday, but volunteers are needed for dinner on Friday.
