Lodge Officer Reports:

Atala and Ocoee chapters met this month at their district round tables. All chapters have been requested to meet on a monthly basis. Chapter Chiefs are to request troop contact information from their District Commissioner. It was also suggested the Camping Chair may be a good resource.

Pack 3266 has requested a ceremony team for their Thanksgiving celebration. Mission district has had several requests as well.

Treasurer presented his report.

Logan Bailey has requested the chapter chiefs to send an e-mail to their members within twenty-four hours of the LECM about key issues. This month's key issues are the Fall Fellowship, Banquet, election changes, and monthly chapter meetings.

Fall Fellowship and Banquet:
